ORDER REVOKING CERTIFICATES
AUTHORIZING ROUND-TRIP SIGHTSEEING-TOUR SERVICE

In Application (A.) 54366 and subsequent applications, passenger stage corporation certificates were granted to The Gray Line Tours Company authorizing round-trip sightseeing-tour services and other services between various points in Southern California.

In Decision (D.) 82-09-087 dated September 22, 1982 in A.59818 (Western Travel Plaza, Inc.) and A.60174 (Kintetsu International Express (USA), Inc.), we concluded that round-trip sightseeing-tour service is not a passenger stage corporation service and that round-trip sightseeing-tour service is not subject to regulation by this Commission. The California Supreme Court, on February 10, 1983, denied a petition for writ of review of D.82-09-087 in SF 24484, Orange County Sightseeing Company v PUC. A petition for rehearing was denied by the Court on March 19, 1983.

Inasmuch as the Commission no longer exercises regulatory jurisdiction over round-trip sightseeing-tour services, passenger stage corporation certificates authorizing such services should be revoked. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The round-trip sightseeing-tour authorities granted to The Gray Line Tours Company in the decisions listed below are revoked and their related tariffs and timetables cancelled on the effective date of this order:

2. The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to The Gray Line Tours Company, a corporation, authorizing it to operate as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 226

of the Public Utilities Code, to transport passengers and baggage is amended as set forth in Appendix PSC-522 (attached).

This order becomes effective 30 days from today.



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ITEM

SECTION I. GENERAL AUTHORIZATIONS.

5 Round-Trip Service

Except as otherwise provided in Item No. 10, The Gray Line Tours Company is authorized to conduct only round-trip passenger stage operations as follows:

Between points of pickup in Service Territories described in SECTION II hereof, on the one hand, and, on the other, the Race Track Points designated in SECTION III and the Miscellaneous Points designated in SECTION IV hereof.

10 One-Way Service

The Gray Line Tours Company is also authorized to conduct one-way passenger stage operations as follows:

- a. From the Santa Anita Race Track to points of discharge in Service Territories designated in Item No. 215 hereof.
- b. From the Hollywood Park Race Track to points of discharge in the Santa Monica Service Territory.
- c. From the Airline Terminals designated in Item No. 315 to points of discharge in the Service Territories designated in Item No. 315; and from points of pickup in the said Service Territories to the said Airline Terminals.

SECTION I. GENERAL AUTHORIZATIONS. (continued)

15 Service Routes

Subject to authority of this Commission to change and modify its passenger stage operations at any time, The Gray Line Tours Company shall conduct said operations along the most appropriate and direct routes.

20 Points Of Pickup And Discharge

Passengers shall be picked up and discharged only at principal hotels, motels, restaurants, and common carrier passenger terminals located within the limits of the specified service territories described in SECTION II hereof.

Exception

- a. Passengers transported in one-way service from Santa Anita Race Track or Hollywood Park Race Track, as authorized in Item No. 10, may be picked up at points adjacent to said Race Tracks.
- b. Passengers transported in one-way service between the Airline Terminals and Service Territories designated in Item No. 315, as authorized in Item No. 10, may also be picked up and discharged at points adjacent to said Airline Terminals.

25 Baggage Limitations

Transportation of baggage shall be limited and incidental to the transportation of passengers pursuant to the San Ysidro Service designated in Item No. 220 and the Airline Terminal Service designated in Item No. 315.

Service Territories, as used herein shall be deemed to include the following:

100 Beverly Hills Territory

All points in Beverly Hills within the area bounded by Sunset Boulevard, Rexford Drive, Olympic Boulevard, and the western boundary of the City of Beverly Hills.

105 Burbank Territory

Territory delineated and bounded by the city limits of the City of Burbank.

110 Colton Territory

Territory delineated and bounded by the city limits of the City of Colton.

115 Culver City Territory

Territory delineated and bounded by the city limits of the City of Culver City.

120 Disneyland Territory

Beginning at the intersection of Ball Road and Euclid Avenue; thence along Euclid Avenue to the Santa Ana Freeway; southeasterly along the Santa Ana Freeway to Katella Avenue; westerly along Katella Avenue to Harbor Boulevard; southerly along Harbor Boulevard to Orangewood Avenue; westerly along Orangewood Avenue to Euclid Avenue; northerly along Euclid Avenue to points of beginning.

125 Eagle Rock Territory

All points along Eagle Rock Boulevard between its intersections with York Boulevard and Colorado Boulevard, and all points along Colorado Boulevard between its intersections with Broadway and North Figueroa Street in the City of Los Angeles.

130 Glendale Territory

Territory delineated and bounded by the city limits of the City of Glendale.

135 Hollywood Territory

Beginning at Sunset Boulevard and La Brea Avenue, southerly along La Brea Avenue to Santa Monica Boulevard; easterly along Santa Monica Boulevard to Gower Street; southerly along Gower Street to Melrose Avenue; easterly along Melrose Avenue to Van Ness Avenue; northerly along Van Ness Avenue to Sunset Boulevard; easterly along Sunset Boulevard to Western Avenue; northerly along Western Avenue to Franklin Avenue; westerly along Franklin Avenue to La Brea Avenue; southerly along La Brea Avenue to point of beginning; and also, including points on and along Sunset Boulevard from the corner of Sunset Boulevard and La Brea Avenue to La Cienega Boulevard.

140 Long Beach Territory

Territory delineated and bounded by the city limits of the City of Long Beach.

Territory delineated and bounded by the city limits of the City of Pasadena.
