ORDER DISMISSING PROCEEDING

By this application the City of Merced requests authority to construct Mistwood Drive at grade across the railroad tracks of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company.

Public hearing was held before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) O'Leary on April 27, 1983 at San Francisco. The matter was submitted with the filing of the transcript on May 31, 1983.

Review of the record discloses deficiencies with respect to the following:

- 1. A Final Environmental Report or Negative Declaration is not contained in the record:
- 2. Exhibit G to the application is an interoffice memorandum to Dennis Cote, Civil Engineer, from the Chief of Police which states in part:

"Eventually, a bridge will be needed across Bear Creek in the northern part of the city. This would make the area north of Bear Creek more accessible and would tie in with the railroad crossing."

There is no evidence as to what effect the bridge will have on the crossing.

3. There is no evidence comparing an underpass alternative to a grade crossing alternative.

Because the required augmentation of the record is so extensive, it will virtually require development of a complete new record. Under the circumstances we think it better to dismiss the application without prejudice and allow applicant to refile at a later date with more complete information.

IT IS ORDERED that Application 6:096 is dismissed without prejudice.

This order is effective today.
