<u>O P I N I O N</u>

Jesse E. Hosch, an individual, dba Jess Hosch, requests a dump truck carrier permit to operate in the Counties of Los Angeles, San Bernardino, Orange, San Diego, and Riverside. Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the Daily Transportation Calendar of June 22, 1983. No protests have been filed. <u>Discussion</u>

Applicant has no other operating authority. His net worth is \$145,000 including \$15,000 cash. He owns one powered transfer unit. His application is supported by an overlying carrier which needs on the average four shipments per day to be subhauled. Revenue from this source is estimated at \$80,000 per year.

Findings of Fact

- 1. Applicant:
 - a. Is a fit and proper person to receive a permit to operate as a dump truck carrier.
 - b. Has sufficient operating knowledge and financial ability to initiate and continue the proposed operation.
 - c. Has demonstrated that the privilege sought:
 - Will not endanger the safety of the public or interfere with the public use of the public highways or impair the condition or maintenance of them, directly or indirectly.

- (2) Will not unnecessarily burden the public highways.
- (3) Is necessary to serve the public and will not impair the ability of presently permitted dump truck carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates.

2. Applicant has resided in the State of California for at least the 90 days preceding the filing of this application.

3. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

4. The following order complies with the Commission's Energy Efficiency Plan.

5. A public hearing is not necessary. Conclusions of Law

1. Applicant should be granted a dump truck carrier permit authorizing operations within and between points in the Counties of Los Angeles, San Bernardino, Orange, San Diego, and Riverside.

2. The following order should be effective today to be consistent with other permit grants.
