## ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Southern California E.T.S., Inc. has failed to submit a certificate of service to the Commission's Docket Office showing that it timely served copies of its application for a new passenger stage corporation certificate on county and city governmental entities and regional transportation planning agencies within whose boundaries applicant intends to load or unload passengers. Such service is required by Rule 21(k) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (Title 20, California Administrative Code Section 21(k)), which further states that "/w/ithin 10 days after filing the application the applicant shall submit a certificate of service to the Commission's Docket Office in San Francisco showing that service was made as directed by this Rule." The necessity for compliance with Rule 21(k) was reiterated to applicant in Administrative Law Judge's Ruling filed July 22, 1983.

IT IS ORDERED that Application 83-07-06 is dismissed without prejudice.
