ORDER MODIFYING DECISION (D.) 83-08-048 AND DENYING REHEARING THEREOF

Pacific Gas & Electric Co. (PG&E) has filed an application for rehearing of D.83-08-048. We have carefully considered each and every allegation of error and are of the opinion that good cause for granting rehearing has not been shown. However, D.83-08-048 should be modified to more clearly establish the basis for our conclusion that 140 basis points is a reasonable cap on PG&E's earnings fluctuations due to unforecasted changes in fuel expenses. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. D.83-08-048 is modified to add the following text to the discussion of PG&E's earnings cap which begins on page 9, mimeo and extends to page 10:

"In doing so we are not unmindful of PG&E's rebuttal testimony. Unfortunately this evidence gave no further insight into how PG&E arrived at its 125 basis points recommendation. To the extent it showed the staff's 160 basis point figure is dependent on which recorded years are used, it supports our conclusion that a lower figure may be appropriate. However, we note that inserting 1982 recorded data into staff's earnings variability comparson further supports the staff's position.

We do agree with PG&E on one point. Setting a fair and reasonable cap on earnings fluctuations is a difficult decision which involves judgement. In our judgement a figure of 140 basis points applied to PG&E's jurisdictional rate base is reasonable given its greater risk vis-a-vis Edison."

2. Rehearing of D.83-08-048 as modified herein is denied.

This order is effective today.
