<u>O P I N I O N</u>

Vincent J. Ganduglia, Inc. (Ganduglia), requests authority to cancel its participation in all California intrastate tariffs issued by Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc. (WMTB) and to concurrently adopt the Commission's Transition Tariff 2, Exception Ratings Tariff 1 and Distance Table 8, at the same level as rates now published by Ganduglia in the WMTB issues.

Ganduglia has determined that a number of efficiencies will accrue to the benefit of Ganduglia's customers as a result of the proposed application.

Ganduglia has also determined that approval of this application will result in technical increases and decreases in certain rates due to differences in rules, but in no case would Ganduglia's gross intrastate revenue increase as much as 1%.

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The application is not a major action significantly affecting energy efficiency within the meaning of Sections 3501.2 and 3502.2 of the Public Utilities (PU) Code.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of September 6, 1983. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

Findings of Fact

1. The increases resulting from this proposal are technical in nature and justified.

2. The following order has no reasonably foreseeable impact on the energy efficiency of highway carriers.

3. Limited authority to depart from the provisions of PU Code Section 461.5 is justified.

4. A public hearing is not necessary. Conclusion of Law

The application should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Vincent J. Ganduglia, Inc. (Ganduglia) is authorized to cancel its participation in all California intrastate tariffs issued by Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc. and concurrently to adopt the Commission's, Transition Tariff 2, Exception Ratings

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Tariff 1 and Distance Table 8 at the same level as rates now published by Ganduglia in the Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc. issues.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made as a result of this order shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than 5 days after the effective date of this order on not less than 5 days notice to the Commission and to the public.

3. Ganduglia, in establishing and maintaining the rates authorized by this application, is authorized to depart from the provisions of PU Code Section 461.5 to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorization; such outstanding authorizations are modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long-and short-haul departures and to this order. 4. The cancellation of applicants participation in Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc. tariffs shall be concurrent with the effective date of the authorized adoption of the Commission tariffs.
