O P I N I O N

Select Travel, Inc.'s (applicant) Class B certificate was granted to a partnership, which included applicant's president, on November 13, 1981, by Commission Decision 93765, in Application 60748 (filed July 21, 1981). Greyhound Lines, Inc. filed a protest and withdrew after applicants (3 partners) agreed that only one vehicle would be used in the service.

Applicant is now a corporation and alleges that the public is demanding more service than it can provide with a single vehicle. It is further alleged that applicant operates out of a terminal in Calabasas Park, Los Angeles County, which county has the largest population in the State of California.

Notice of the application appeared on the Commission's Daily Transportation Calendar of June 22, 1983 and no protest has been received.

We find and conclude that the restriction should be removed and the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that the use of a single-vehicle restriction in applicant's charter-party certificate is vacated.

This order is effective today.


