O P I N I O N

On July 3, 1973 in Case 9581 this Commission opened an investigation into the adequacy and reliability of the energy and fuel requirements and supply of electric corporations.

On December 18, 1982 in Case 9642, an investigation into the natural gas supply and requirements of gas corporations was commenced. The two matters were consolidated for hearing.

Hearings were held throughout the state with many decisions issued including the establishment of the state's natural gas priority system. Given the current status of the nation's natural gas supply and the reliability of our electric and gas corporations, we believe the investigations should be discontinued. In addition, all reporting required of gas utilities by orders issued in these proceedings should be discontinued.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Cases 9581 and 9642 are discontinued.
2. All reporting requirements contained in prior orders issued in Cases 9581 and 9642 are discontinued.

This order becomes effective 30 days from today.
