ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Decision (D.) 89662 dated November 28, 1978 dismissed Case (C.) 9625, our investigation into the need for promulgation of a general order providing for procedures and standards to be followed for the interconnection of customer-provided communication terminal equipment, with related matters. Complaint cases involving the interconnection of customer-provided ancillary and data equipment were consolidated with C.9625 by D.82412 dated January 29, 1974.

The consolidated matters were dismissed after the adoption of General Order 138 in D.84364 dated April 22, 1975, as modified by D.85791, 87620, and 87920 and Commission Resolution T-9826, had resolved the issues for the interconnection of customer-provided equipment.

C.9758 should have been included with the cases consolidated with C.9625. Since this case was omitted and the issues for the interconnection of customer-provided equipment have been resolved, we conclude that C.9758 should be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that Case 9758 is dismissed.


