ORDER MODIFYING DECISION (D.) 83-10-031  
 AND DENYING REHEARING

An application for rehearing and request for stay of D.83-10-031 has been filed by Sierra Association for Environment. We have considered each and every allegation of error in that application and have concluded that the stay and rehearing should be denied. However, certain editorial errors in D.83-10-031 are potentially confusing. The corrections are set forth below.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. D.83-10-031 is modified as follows:

(a) Change ordering paragraph 2.A. to read:

"A quarterly report ~~will~~ until the roll date for ..."

(b) In ordering paragraph 2.A.3., fourth line, change "phase" to "phases".

(c) In ordering paragraph 11, fourth line, change "included" to "including".

(d) In ordering paragraph 13, change "measure" (fourth line) to "measures", and add the underlined letters to "adjustments"

and "unforeseen" (eighth line).

(e) The first sentence of the second paragraph of page 15 of the Opinion shall read:

"In making its recommendations, staff stated ~~it-recognized-that-Edison-is-sufficiently-to-substitute-for-the-Balsam-Meadow-project-but~~ urged that Edison continue to vigorously pursue three conservation and load management programs."

(f) The last two lines of page 3 of the Opinion shall read:

"tailing quantity changes are approximated.  
~~in-Attachment-1.~~"

2. Rehearing of D.83-10-031 as modified herein is denied.


