INTERIM ORDER MODIFYING DECISIONS

Decision No. 86081, dated July 7, 1976, Decision No. 85289, dated December 30, 1975, and Decision No. 85189, dated December 2, 1975, required that certain conservation plans and reports be filed with this Commission.

Staff analysis indicates that a revised schedule of more complete reports and analysis would be most productive in assisting the Commission to meet its policy goals on energy conservation. The Commission finds that Ordering Paragraphs 1 and 2 of Decision No. 85289, Paragraphs 10 and 11 of Decision No. 85189, and Paragraph 2 of Decision No. 86081 should be modified as follows:

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Pacific Gas and Electric Company, San Diego Gas & Electric Company, Southern California Edison Company, and

Southern California Gas Company shall annually file by not later than December 1, a comprehensive plan for energy conservation for the subsequent year.

2. Pacific Gas and Electric Company, San Diego Gas & Electric Company, Southern California Edison Company, and Southern California Gas Company shall file annually by not later than March 31, of each year commencing March 31, 1977, an analysis of the cost and effectiveness of the prior year's conservation programs.

3. Southern California Edison Company, San Diego Gas & Electric Company, and Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall maintain data and continue to report to the Commission monthly on the effectiveness of the individual utility voluntary conservation programs. California-Pacific Utilities Company, Pacific Power & Light Company, and Sierra Pacific Power Company shall maintain data and continue to report similar data to the Commission annually rather than monthly. All other respondent electric utility companies may discontinue reporting on conservation effectiveness programs as required by D-84062.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that introductory Paragraph Number 2 of Appendix A, Decision No. 86081 be reworded to read as follows:

"2. The criteria for categorizing the uses of electricity as of the effective date of this decision are as follows:"

The effective date of this order shall be ten days after the date hereof unless within said ten days a protest to it is filed by any party in which event this order shall remain stayed pending further order of the Commission. Such protest shall set forth the specific grounds of objection to this Interim Order and shall constitute the opportunity to be heard provided by Public Utilities Code Section 1708. In the event this Interim Order is stayed by a protest, all other parties will have an additional ten days to reply to said protest.
