ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR
RECONSIDERATION AND MODIFICATION

In Resolution No. G-1932, adopted July 27, 1976, the Commission rejected the tariff revisions filed by SDG&E pursuant to our previous order in Decision No. 86049, issued June 29, 1976.

Thereafter, Resolution No. G-1936 was adopted on August 17, 1976, in which we ordered that SDG&E pass on to its customers any refunds and/or rate reductions received from its supplier, Southern California Gas Company.

An August 26, 1976, SDG&E filed a petition for reconsideration and modification of Resolution No. G-1936. Thereafter, the Commission adopted Resolution No. G-1962, in which it withdrew the order in Resolution No. G-1932, and allowed SDG&E to place its tariff sheets into effect as of September 28, 1976. By letter dated October 7, 1976, SDG&E requested that its petition for reconsideration or modification of Resolution No. 1936 be withdrawn. Good cause appearing therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the petition for reconsideration and modification of Resolution No. 1936 is hereby dismissed.
