ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 85026 dated October 21, 1975 in the instant application, Service Transport Lines, Inc. was authorized to depart from the minimum rates set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 for the transportation of:

1. Culvert or pipe, aluminum, corrugated as described in Item 51020 through 51025 of the National Motor Freight Classification; and
2. Hardware and fittings necessary for the assembly and use of culvert or pipe in paragraph 1, in mixed shipments with aluminum culvert or pipe.

The authority is scheduled to expire October 21, 1976.

By letter dated September 24, 1976 applicant requests a 90-day extension of the expiration date set forth in Decision No. 85026. Applicant alleges that it overlooked filing its application for renewal of the authority and is presently in the process of preparing such an application.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the expiration date set forth in Decision No. 85026 is extended to January 21, 1977.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
