In the matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC TRANSPORTATION COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of an industrial lead track in, upon, along or across Eighth Street in the City of Long Beach, County of Los Angeles, State of California.

OPINION

Southern Pacific Transportation Company requests authority to construct an industrial lead track at grade across Eighth Street in the City of Long Beach, County of Los Angeles.

The industrial lead track will serve the facilities of the Port of Long Beach.

Motice of the application was published in the Commission's Daily Calendar on January 10, 1975. No protests have been received. A public hearing is not necessary.

<u>FINDINGS</u>

After consideration, the Commission finds:

- 1. Applicant should be authorized to construct an industrial lead track at grade across Eighth Street in the City of Long Beach, County of Los Angeles at the location and substantially as shown by plan attached to the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing BH-503.56.
- 2. Construction of the crossing should be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 (General Order 72-3).

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Southern Pacific Transportation Company is authorized to construct an industrial lead track at grade across Eighth Street in the City of Long Beach, County of Los Angeles, as set forth in the findings of this decision.

2. Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.

This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if the above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
