## ORDER DENYING REHEARING OR RECONSIDERATION

On January 13, 1976, the Commission issued Decision No. 85347, cancelling the certificate of public convenience and necessity previously held by Northgate Transit Company, Inc. (Northgate), and issuing a probationary certificate set to expire August 31, 1976, in lieu thereof. This decision contemplated that a hearing would be held to consider whether Northgate achieved compliance with certain requirements. No such hearing having yet been held, on August 24, 1976, the Commission adopted Decision No. 86319, extending the expiration date of the probationary certificate until December 31, 1976, and setting hearing for November 22, 1976. On September 7, 1976, the City of Daly City filed a petition for rehearing or reconsideration, requesting that Decision No. 86319 be revoked.

Having fully reviewed Daly City's petition, we find that good cause has not been shown to grant rehearing in this matter. Specifically, we find that the extension of the expiration date of Northgate's certificate was a reasonable and appropriate means of maintaining an essential transportation service pending a hearing set for the near future.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that rehearing or reconsideration of Decision No. 86319 is hereby denied.
