The service is of the "home-to-work" character, providing commute transportation between these residential neighborhoods and the United Airlines Maintenance Base at the San Francisco International Airport. By this application, Whippet requests authority to increase by \$1.50 per week the following passenger stage fares:

Whippet expects to operate at a loss during 1976 unless it is granted immediate relief by way of a fare increase to defray the insurance costs. The increase in revenue with the proposed fares is estimated by the applicant to be \$29,600 annually.

The highest of the applicant's proposed fares would still be lower than those of similar and comparable transportation service,
