ORDER DENYING REHEARING OR RECONSIDERATION





On February 27, 1976, Northgate Transit Co., Inc. (Northgate) filed Application No. 56301, seeking to increase fares with respect to its certificated passenger stage service to Daly City and surrounding communities. After holding public hearings, the Commission issued Decision No. 86338 on August 31, 1976, authorizing the proposed fare increase. On September 13, 1976, the City of Daly City filed a petition for rehearing or reconsideration of Decision No. 86338.

Having fully reviewed Daly City's petition, we find that good cause has not been shown to grant rehearing in this matter. Specifically, we find that the findings and conclusions stated in Decision No. 86338 were amply supported by the record and provided a substantial basis for the decision rendered.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that rehearing or reconsideration of Decision No. 86338 is hereby denied.
