SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision 69923 dated November 9, 1965 in Application 46541 a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a cement carrier was issued to Bulk Transportation. Because of its affiliation with several other entities an alter-ego restriction was placed on Appendix A of the decision which described the applicant's scope of operating authority.

It has come to our attention that control of Bulk Transportation was subsequently acquired, but prior to the enactment of Section 854 of the Public Utilities Code which requires Commission approval to acquire such control, by George G. Cross through purchase of all outstanding shares of common stock. The new owner, although not affiliated with the entities referred to in the aforementioned appendix, controls California and Western States Ammonia Transport, Inc., an entity which we recently authorized to purchase certificates of public convenience and necessity to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier and as a cement carrier.

In the circumstances, it appears and the Commission finds and concludes that Appendix A of Decision 69923 should be revised to reflect the present affiliation. A public hearing is not necessary.

Appendix A (D. 69923)

BULK TRANSPORTATION (a corporation)

First Revised Page 1 Cancels Original Page 1

Bulk Transportation, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to operate as a cement carrier as defined in Section 214.1 of the Public Utilities Code to and within the Counties of Fresno, Imperial, Inyo, Kern, Los Angeles, Merced, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, San Diego, San Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara and Ventura from any and all points of origin.

*Restrictions:

- 1. This certificate of public convenience and necessity shall lapse and terminate if not exercised for a period of one year.
- Whenever Bulk Transportation engages other carriers for the transportation of property of Bulk Transportation or California and Western States Ammonia Transport, Inc., or customers or suppliers of said corporations, carrier shall not pay such other carriers rates and charges less than the rates and charges published in the carrier's tariffs on file with the Commission for the transportation actually performed by such other carriers.
