ORDER OF DISMISSAL


Petition 96 in Case No. 5330 filed by California Moving and Storage Association requested that public hearing be held for the receipt of evidence concerning the need for rules governing the advertising practices of carriers engaged in the transportation of used household goods.

Petition 96 was consolidated for hearing with Case No. 10151, an investigation into the advertising, rules, and practices of carriers engaged in the transportation of used household goods. At the public hearing held on October 20, 1976, petitioner requested that Petition 96 be dismissed because petitioner plans to introduce its proposed rules with respect to advertising in Case No. 10151.


Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Petition for Modification No. 96 in Case No. 5330 is dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.


