ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decisions Nos. 85844, 85845, and 85846 dated May 18, 1976, Tony Lucchetti, doing business as Rodeway Transport, was granted temporary authority to deviate from the minimum rates for transportation for Tonkin Corp. of California, Seven-Up Bottling Co., Capitol Beverage Packers, Pepsi-Cola Bottling Co., and Royal Crown Beverage Company, Inc. Those authorities will expire November 18, 1976.

Final determination cannot be accomplished before the current authority expires. It is appropriate, therefore, to extend the present authority to March 31, 1977.


IT IS ORDERED that:


