ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 85876 dated May 25, 1976, Parker & Son Trucking, Inc. was granted temporary authority to deviate from the minimum rates for the transportation of beer. That authority will expire November 25, 1976.

Final determination cannot be accomplished before the current authority expires. It is appropriate, therefore, to extend the present authority to January 31, 1977.

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. The authority granted by Decision No. 85876 shall expire on January 31, 1977, unless sooner canceled, modified, or extended by order of the Commission.


2. In all other respects Decision No. 85876 shall remain in full force and effect.


