ORDER SUSPENDING REFUND ORDER

On November 23, 1976, we issued Decision No. 86681 in the above-entitled proceeding and therein denied rehearing of Decision No. 86118. Petitioner, Southern California Gas Company, had requested a partial stay in the event its petition for rehearing was denied.

We are of the opinion that good cause exists to suspend the refund order in Decision No. 86681 pending Supreme Court review of Decision No. 86118.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:



1. The order in Decision No. 86681 requiring refunds is hereby suspended pending further order of the Commission.
