ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision 75806 dated June 24, 1969, in Application 50879, Sequoia Stages, a California corporation, doing business as Eastshore Lines, was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation (PSC-624) to transport passengers between Lafayette, Moraga, Orinda Village and intermediate points; and between Marinwood and San Marin in Marin County, on the one hand, and the City of San Francisco, on the other hand.

Counsel for applicant notified the Commission staff by letter dated October 15, 1976 that the carrier is no longer operating pursuant to its authority granted by Decision 75806. Counsel stated that Marinwood and San Marin are served by the Golden Gate Transit District and Lafayette, Moraga and Orinda Village are served by the Alameda-Contra Costa Transit District.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation authorized by Decision 75806 in Application 50879 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Sequoia Stages, a California corporation, doing business as Eastshore Lines (PSC-624), are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The Executive Director shall mail a certified copy of this order to Sequoia Stages at 55 Townsend Street, San Francisco, CA 94107 and to Eldon M. Johnson at The Hartford Building, 650 California Street, Suite 2808, San Francisco, CA 94108, last known addresses as shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
