ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 85896 dated June 2, 1976, Patrick L. Barnes, dba Barnes Package Express Service, was authorized to deviate from the minimum rates for shipments weighing 100 pounds or less between points in the San Francisco Bay Area. That authority will expire December 2, 1976.

Final determination cannot be accomplished before the current authority expires. It is appropriate, therefore, to extend the present authority to January 31, 1977.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The authority granted by Decision No. 85896 shall expire on January 31, 1977, unless sooner canceled, modified, or extended by order of the Commission.
