In the Matter of the Application of MARINO BROS. TRUCKING CO. for an order authorizing departure from the rates, rules and regulations of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3666 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of glass, flat, not bent, from Lathrop to various points in Southern California for Libbey-Owens-Ford Company.

ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 85883 dated June 2, 1976, Marino Bros. Trucking Co. was authorized to deviate from the minimum rates for the transportation of property for Libbey-Owens-Ford Company. That authority will expire December 2, 1976.

Final determination cannot be accomplished before the current authority expires. It is appropriate, therefore, to extend the present authority to January 31, 1977.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The authority granted by Decision No. 85883 shall expire on January 31, 1977, unless sooner canceled, modified, or extended by order of the Commission.

2. In all other respects Decision No. 85883 shall remain in full force and effect.
