ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision 84324, dated April 15, 1975, in Application 54999, Vannett Incorporated, doing business as Vannett Lines, was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a Passenger Stage Corporation (PSC 966), to transport passengers between certain points in east Los Angeles County, on the one hand, and Hughes Aircraft facilities at El Segundo, Culver City and the Los Angeles International Airport, on the other hand.

On September 1, 1976, the Commission staff was notified by the applicant that it ceased operations as a Passenger Stage Corporation on March 1, 1976. It still continues to operate as a Charter-party Carrier of Passengers (TCP-47A).

It appears and the Commission finds that this matter constitutes good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a Passenger Stage Corporation authorized by Decision 84324 in Application 54999 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Vannett Incorporated, doing business as Vannett Lines, are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The Executive Director shall mail a certified copy of this order to Vannett Incorporated, doing business as Vannett Lines, at P. O. Box 893, Glendora, CA 91740, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
