INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, John M. Brainerd, doing business as Flo-Del Co., requests authority to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariffs 1-B, 2 and 19 in connection with the transportation of packages and parcels weighing 100 pounds or less between points within a radius of 100 miles of San Francisco.¹

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of September 13, 1976. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant's proposal is reasonable on a temporary basis pending hearing. The Commission concludes that interim authority should be granted and the effective date of this order should be the date hereof because there is an immediate need for this rate relief.

Package and Parcel Delivery Rates

Application

1. The rates set forth herein are applicable only to the transportation of packages and parcels weighing 100 pounds or less between points set forth herein.
2. The rate for the transportation of packages or parcels between points within Zone 1 as provided in the Zone Schedule, shall be the rate as set forth in the Rate Schedule for Zone 1.
3. The rate for the transportation of packages or parcels between points within Zone 2, as provided in the Zone Schedule, shall be the rate as set forth in the Rate Schedule for Zone 2.
4. The rate for the transportation of packages or parcels between points in two zones shall be the rate applicable to the higher of the two zones as provided in the Rate Schedule.

Rules

1. The minimum charge per package or parcel shall be 65 cents for Zone 1 and 68 cents for Zone 2.
2. Released valuation: The rates herein apply only when the released or declared value is 50 cents per pound or less, and the maximum value per package or article is \$50 or less.

EXCEPTION: Where there is declared value in excess of \$50 upon notification by shipper, an additional charge of 25 cents shall be made for each \$100 or fraction thereof of declared value in excess of \$50.

Rules (Continued)

3. The provisions of Items 182, 250, 255 and Supplement 75 (Central Coastal Territory surcharges) of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 shall not apply to the rates herein when such rates are otherwise subject to the rates in said tariff.
4. Collection of charges: The rules as provided in Item 145 of MPT 1-B shall be applicable to all shipments transported under the rates authorized herein.
5. An additional charge of 85 cents shall be assessed for each C.O.D shipment received for collection.
6. If the carrier is unable to deliver any package because of incorrect address, shipper shall be assessed a charge of 85 cents for either the subsequent delivery or carrier's attempt to deliver to correct address.
7. All transportation charges shall be paid by the shipper.
8. The rates and charges stated herein shall not apply to transportation pursuant to applicant's highway common carrier's operations, as authorized by Commission Decision 58628, Application Numbers 21879, 28194 and 33516.
9. Applicant has not indicated that subhaulers will be engaged nor have any costs of subhaulers been submitted. Therefore, if subhaulers are employed, they shall be paid no less than the rates authorized herein without any deduction for use of applicant's trailing equipment.
10. In all other respects, the rates and rules in Minimum Rate Tariffs 1-B, 19 and 2 shall apply, as the case may be.
