accordance with the testimony and exhibits of the Commission staff witness on this subject, to specific rates named in said tariff in lieu of the present 5 percent surcharge."



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petitions for rehearing of Decision No. 86507 filed by California Trucking Association and Norris Industries be denied.
