ORDER DENYING MODIFICATION OF DECISION NO. 86678

On November 30, 1976, TURN filed its petition for modification of Decision No. 86678. In its petition TURN alleges that it is confused as to the date from which rates collected by Pacific for residential single message rate timing (SMRT) are subject to refund. Decision No. 86678 made timed single message residential rates subject to refund until further order of the Commission. The effective date of Decision No. 86678 was November 23, 1976. Since our orders operate prospectively, only charges for residential SMRT collected for service rendered after November 23, 1976, would be subject to refund.
