ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 85424 dated February 3, 1976, applicant J. S. Shafer, Jr., was authorized, pending public hearing, to deviate from the minimum rates for transportation services provided for Griffith Company. That authority will expire December 31, 1976.

Final determination cannot be accomplished before the current authority expires. It is appropriate therefore to extend the present authority to June 30, 1977.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The authority granted by Decision No. 85424 shall expire on June 30, 1977 unless sooner canceled, modified, or extended by order of the Commission.
