## Decision No. <u>86805</u>

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of CITY FREIGHT LINES, a California corporation, for authority to deviate from minimum rates pursuant to Section 3666 of the Public Utilities Code for the transportation of conduits or pipe, cement and asbestos fibre.

#### INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, City Freight Lines, a corporation, requests authority to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 in connection with the transportation of cement and asbestos fibre conduits or pipe for Certain-Teed Products Corporation from its plant site at Crestmore to points in California within 300 miles of said origin.<sup>1</sup>

The application is based on special circumstances and conditions detailed therein.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of June 2, 1976. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant's proposal is reasonable, on an interim basis, to the extent hereinafter indicated. Applicant contemplates the use of subhaulers with remuneration at 82 percent of the deviation rates sought based upon the type of trailing equipment furnished by applicant. While applicant has provided an analysis of a representative subhauler's cost, there is no indication that any one subhauler will actually experience such a cost. The provisions for the payment to subhaulers have not been justified and will not be authorized. The Commission will consider actual costs of subhaulers when they join in the application and submit same. The Commission concludes that the effective date of this order should be the date hereof because there is an immediate need for this relief.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. City Freight Lines, a corporation, is authorized to perform the transportation shown in Appendix A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof at not less than the rates set forth, and subject to the conditions specified, therein.

2. The authority granted herein shall expire one year after the effective date of this order unless sooner cancelled, modified or extended by further order of the Commission.

3. A public hearing shall be scheduled on this application at a date to be set.

#### CITY FREIGHT LINES (a corporation)

SHIPPER: CERTAIN-TEED PRODUCTS CORPORATION

ORIGIN: Plant site of Certain-Teed Products Corporation, Crestmore.

COMMODITY: Conduits or pipe, cement and asbestos fibre, and in connection therewith, equipment of rubber washers necessary in joining of pipe not to exceed five percent of weight upon which charges are assessed.

CONDITIONS:

- 1. Rates shall not apply on shipments having a prior or subsequent movement by water or rail.
- 2. Shipments rated, or subject to rates applicable on a minimum weight of 36,000 pounds or more, shall apply per unit of carrier's equipment.
- 3. Shipper shall load carrier's equipment without charge to carrier.
- 4. Rates shall not apply to C.O.D. shipments.
- 5. Though applicant has indicated that subhaulers will be engaged, no adequate costs of subhaulers have been submitted. Therefore, if subhaulers are employed, they shall be paid no less than the rates authorized herein without any deduction for use of applicant's trailing equipment.
- 6. In all other respects, the rates and rules in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 shall apply.
