ORDER OF DISMISSAL

California Trucking Association, in the above petition, requests that the Commission recalculate the constructive mileages and amend its Distance Tables 7 and 8 to compensate motor carriers for increases in toll charges incurred by them as of July 1, 1976, when operating over the Carquinez and Benicia-Martinez Bridges.

The Commission, after review of the matter, concludes that it should be considered at the time Distance Table 9 is formulated and the instant petition should be dismissed. Any application of a common carrier seeking authority to publish a provision in its tariff reimbursing it for the aforementioned increases in bridge tolls will be given prompt attention.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Case 7024, Petition for Modification 36, is dismissed without prejudice.
