SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision 86751, dated December 14, 1976, Cristina Warehouse Co., Inc. was authorized to increase its rates for the storage and handling of property at San Jose. The decision authorized tariff filings effective on not less than thirty days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

Applicant has informed the Commission that it neglected to seek less-than-statutory notice in its application. As the delay in effecting the authorized increase would cause it to incur an undue hardship, it requests such short notice authority.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant's request is reasonable and justified. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Decision 86751 should be amended as set forth in the ensuing order and the effective date of this order should be the date hereof because there is an immediate need for this relief.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ordering paragraph 1 of Decision 86751 is amended by substituting therefor the following:

"1. Cristina Warehouse Co., Inc. is authorized to establish the increased rates proposed in Application 56853. Tariff publications authorized to be made as a result of this order shall be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public."

2. In all other respects, Decision 86751, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
