ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 86739 dated December 14, 1976, applicants Preston Trucking Co. and Pellco Trucking, Inc. were authorized to deviate from the minimum rates for the transportation of beer between points in the San Francisco Bay Area and points in southern California. On December 24, 1976, California Trucking Association (CTA) filed a petition for rehearing and/or reconsideration of Decision No. 86739. The timely filing of that petition stayed that order.

Both applicants had been operating pursuant to temporary authorities granted by Decisions Nos. 84720 and 85875, as amended. In consideration of the petition filed by CTA, and in order to avoid undue hardship, it is appropriate that the temporary authorities be extended to February 28, 1977.
