SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision 86481, dated October 5, 1976, in Application 56512, the Commission ordered, among other things, that the five grade crossings authorized, Ringwood Avenue (Crossing DA-43.06-C), Concourse Drive (Crossing DA-43.24-C), Fortune Drive (Crossing DA-43.52-C), Lundy Avenue (Crossing DA-43.44-C) and Trade Drive (Crossing DA-43.57-C) over the tracks of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company in the City of San Jose, Santa Clara County, should be constructed equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order 72-B.

In view of the anticipated light railroad traffic at the crossings, the Southern Pacific Transportation Company, by letter dated November 30, 1976, requested modification of Decision 86481 to provide that the construction of the grade crossings be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 instead of Standard No. 2 of General Order 72-B.

The City of San Jose is amenable to the proposed construction modification, according to its letter of December 23, 1976 to the Commission.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision 86481 be modified as follows:
Finding 2 which reads:

A. 56512 TLR

"2. Construction of the crossing should be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order 72-B." shall be changed to read:

2. Construction of the crossings should be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 of General Order 72-B.

In all other respects, said Decision 86481 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
