ORDER SUSPENDING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

By Decision No. 85173, dated November 25, 1975, the operative right of Lyon Moving & Storage Co. (Lyon) covering warehouse operations at La Mesa was suspended for a period of one year so that Lyon would have the time to find a new warehouse location. By this application, authority is sought to suspend said operative right for a further one-year period.

Applicant states that it has been unable to acquire suitable facilities to replace those which it lost due to expiration of its lease. Applicant asserts that it intends to reinstate warehouse activities in the vicinity of La Mesa shortly.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that suspension of the operative right, as requested, would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted and the effective date of this order should be the date hereof because the current suspension authority has expired.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive operative right of Lyon Moving & Storage Co. covering public utility warehouse operations at La Mesa is suspended to and including January 25, 1978.
2. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall amend its tariffs presently on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

3. The Acting Executive Director is directed to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
