ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The probationary certificate to operate as a passenger stage corporation issued to Northgate Transit Company, Inc. in Decision No. 86319 expired pursuant to that decision at midnight December 31, 1976 at which time the passenger stage operations and corporate ownership of Northgate Transit Company, Inc. were taken over by the San Mateo County Transit District. The expiration of the former's certificate renders the issues presented by Cases Nos. 9829 and 9907 moot and the District has requested in writing that those cases be dismissed.

In Application No. 55352 applicant Daly City Transit System's Inc. sought a certificate to conduct operations as a passenger stage corporation in competition with Northgate Transit Company, Inc., Communication with Daly City Transit System's Inc. has been attempted by the Commission staff on several occasions to no avail leading it to believe that the corporation is defunct.

IT IS ORDERED that Cases Nos. 9829 and 9907 and Application No. 55352 are dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
