ORDER FURTHER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 85886 dated June 2, 1976 Trans-Aero Systems Corporation was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier between points in the San Francisco Territory. By Decision No. 86427 dated September 21, 1976 we amended Decision No. 85886 to extend the date for filing of tariffs. Applicant now requests an additional extension because its tariff bureau has not been able to complete the work necessary for such tariff filings.

We find the request to be reasonable and conclude that it should be granted. Because the present authority is due to expire on or about February 18, 1977 we will make the order effective on the date signed.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ordering Paragraph 2(b) of Decision No. 85886 is amended to read:

- (b) Within three hundred and thirty days after the effective date of this order, applicant shall establish the authorized service and file tariffs, in triplicate, in the Commission's office.
