ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision 84706 dated July 29, 1975, in Application 55147, Borderland Transportation Company, Inc., doing business as Great Western Stage Lines, was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a Passenger Stage Corporation between certain points in Southern California.

Since June 7, 1976, Borderland Transportation Company, Inc., has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order 101-C.

By letter dated November 5, 1976 the carrier was placed on notice that its authority would be revoked if it did not provide passenger carrier service, since the Commission staff had been notified that the carrier had ceased its passenger stage operations.

The carrier was requested to reply to the Commission staff's allegation within ten days from the date of the letter or the Commission staff would recommend to the Commission that its authority be revoked.

The carrier has not replied to the Commission staff's letter.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables

applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a Passenger Stage Corporation authorized by Decision 84706 in Application 55147 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Borderland Transportation Company, Inc., doing business as Great Western Stage Lines, are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The Acting Executive Director shall mail a certified copy of this order to Borderland Transportation Company, Inc., dba Great Western Stage Lines, at 8747 Baird Avenue, Northridge, CA 91324, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after the above mailing to Borderland Transportation Company, Inc., last known address, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
