OPINION AND ORDER

By our Interim Opinion, Decision No. 84940 dated September 30, 1975, we authorized The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company to file provisional tariffs covering the offering of 801A dial PBX service. This order required that Pacific notify its customers of the temporary nature of the authorized tariff and required quarterly filings to be made setting forth applicant's realized costs of providing the service.

Subsequent to the issuance of the Commission order, applicant determined that it did not intend to provide 801A dial PBX service to new applicants. By Advice Letter No. 12051, filed July 20, 1976 and authorized by Resolution No. T-9452, the offering of this service was limited to customers receiving the same service as of August 20, 1976.

Based upon the cost data collected between March, 1975 and March, 1976 pursuant to the interim order, applicant determined that the provisional rates did not fully cover the costs of providing the service. Accordingly, applicant filed Advice Letter No. 12212 on December 22, 1976 to increase rates for 801A dial PBX service then being furnished to some 133 customers. By Resolution No. T-9557 the Commission authorized this rate revision which resulted in an annual revenue increase of approximately \$90,000.

The Commission finds that the reporting requirements of Decision No. 84940 have served their purpose as reflected in the increased rates filed by Pacific for this service, and concludes that existing tariffs should be made permanent; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the tariffs filed pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 84940, and subsequently modified by Commission resolution, are hereby made permanent.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company is hereby relieved of the reporting requirements of Ordering Paragraphs 3 and 4 of Decision No. 84940.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
