ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision 80329, dated August 1, 1972, in Application 53269, Cal Coast Charter, Inc., was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a Passenger Stage Corporation (PSC-894) between certain southern portions of Ventura County and the northwestern portion of Los Angeles County.

On November 19, 1976, the Commission staff sent a letter by certified mail to W. M. Boucher of Cal Coast Charter, Inc., advising that the staff was informed that the carrier was no longer exercising its authority, and asking for verification.

On November 29, 1976 the Commission staff received a letter from the carrier stating that it had abandoned its passenger service.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a Passenger Stage Corporation authorized by Decision 80329 in Application 53269 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Cal Coast Charter, Inc., are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The Acting Executive Director shall mail a certified copy of this order to W. M. Boucher, Cal Coast Charter, Inc., at 2557 Cortez Street, Oxnard, CA 93031, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the effective date of this order.
