O P I N I O N

In Case No. 10217 complainants request bill adjustments from Southern California Water Company for water service to their apartment houses at 3818 W. 102nd Street in the city of Inglewood and at 1235 W. 94th Street in the city of Los Angeles based upon prior water consumption at those locations. The amount of reparation was left subject to proof at the hearing.

In Case No. 10218, complainants request a bill adjustment from Southern California Gas Company for gas service to their apartment house at 3818 W. 102nd Street in the city of Inglewood for failure to remove master meters and to separately meter certain apartment units on a timely basis and to base the adjustment on prior billings at this location. Complainants request a \$275 adjustment.

Pursuant to Rule 13.2 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, complainants and defendants consented to the Expedited Complaint Procedure and waived the presence of a court reporter and a record of the hearing and findings of fact and conclusions of law. These matters were heard on a consolidated basis on February 16, 1977 by Examiner Jerry Levander.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The relief requested in Case No. 10217 is denied.
2. The relief requested in Case No. 10218 is denied.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
