ORDER GRANTING LIMITED REHEARING
OF DECISION NO. 86807

The Commission has considered each and every contention made by California-American Water Company in its application for rehearing filed January 14, 1977, and concludes that rehearing should be granted, limited to the propriety of the Commission's ordering paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 86807. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Rehearing of ordering paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 86807 is granted.

2. Rehearing shall be held before such Commissioner and Examiner and at such time and place as may be hereafter designated. The Executive Director is directed to cause appropriate notice of rehearing to be mailed at least ten (10) days before such rehearing.

3. Pending our decision on rehearing, ordering paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 86807 is suspended. In all other respects Decision No. 86807 shall continue in full force and effect hereafter.
