O P I N I O N

Complainant requests reparations and cancellation of billings for several months during which she was continually subjected to harassing telephone calls from an unnamed third party. She made disputed bill deposits with the Commission totalling \$276.93. Her claim also involves reparations for bills paid in prior periods in an unspecified amount.

Pursuant to Rule 13.2 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, complainant and defendant consented to the Expedited Complaint Procedure and waived the presence of a court reporter and a record of the hearing and findings of fact and conclusions of law. This matter was heard on February 18, 1977 by Examiner Gilman.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Complainant is denied any relief.
2. The Executive Director shall release to defendant all funds deposited by complainant in conjunction with this complaint.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
