ORDER RESCINDING DECISION NO. 86467  
AND DISMISSING APPLICATION NO. 55380

By Decision No. 86467 dated October 5, 1976 in Application No. 54999, the Economic Opportunity Commission of Imperial County, Inc. (EOC) was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation (PSC-1007) to transport passengers both in a "dial-a-ride" service and a scheduled service generally within the irrigated area of the Imperial Valley.

On November 22, 1976 the EOC informed the Commission that it could not accept the certificate as granted. One hundred twenty days have elapsed without the service being established as required by Decision No. 86467. The various filings as ordered by that decision have not been made.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for rescinding Decision No. 86467 and dismissing Application No. 54349.

The EOC is hereby placed on notice that it shall not operate a service as described in Decision No. 86467 or operate any service for which the Public Utilities Code requires either a certificate or permit without first receiving the proper authority from this Commission.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 86467 is rescinded and Application No. 55380 is dismissed without prejudice.

The Executive Director shall mail a certified copy of this order to the Economic Opportunity Commission of Imperial County, Inc., Cameron Hendry, Executive Director, 510 Main Street, El Centro, CA 92243, the last known address shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
