ORDER DENYING REHEARING OF DECISION NO. 86882

On February 9, 1977, Robert A. Burns filed a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 86882. After reviewing each and every allegation the Commission is of the opinion that good cause for rehearing has not been shown to exist. However, modification of Decision No. 86882 is required to include reference to all relevant items contained in the formal file.

THEREFORE, it is ordered that:

1. Rehearing of Decision No. 86882 is hereby denied.

2. Paragraph 2 of page 2 of Decision No. 86882 is modified to read:

"This complaint fails to allege sufficient facts to establish a cause of action. It is not sufficient for complainant to merely make a conclusionary statement to the effect that his proffered revision to the credit rule is appropriate and that without it the rule is unjust and unreasonable. The complaint, accordingly, is legally insufficient and should be

dismissed. Complainant's attempted amendment of the complaint to include reference to the credit rules of Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company was not filed in accordance with the Commission's rules of Practice and procedure and therefore could not have been considered in this proceeding. Additionally, the attempted amendment was insufficient to cure the infirmity of the original complaint."
