ORDER RESTORING MINIMUM RATES AND SETTING HEARING

By Decisions Nos. 85584, 85585, 85586 and 85587 issued March 16, 1976, the Commission exempted the transportation of empty sea vans and flattened automobile bodies from the application of the minimum rates named in Minimum Rate Tariffs 2, 1-B, 9-B and 19. By Decision No. 85789 dated May 4, 1976, the Commission denied a petition for rehearing of the above decisions filed by California Trucking Association (CTA). CTA's subsequent Petition to the California Supreme Court for a Writ of Review was granted in S. F. No. 23473. On March 24, 1977, the Supreme Court filed its decision in that matter annulling Decisions Nos. 85584, 85585, 95586 and 85587 on the ground that CTA should have the opportunity to be heard in a formal hearing.

Although the Commission realizes that the annullment of its decisions will automatically restore the previous minimum rates for these commodities, it believes that the subscribers to the involved tariffs should be made aware of this fact and that the appropriate tariff pages should be revised to show the effect of the annullment.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the involved tariffs should be amended by eliminating the exemptions for empty sea vans and flattened automobile bodies and restoring the minimum rates for such commodities. The Commission further finds that a hearing should be set in these proceedings to consider whether the transportation of these commodities should be exempted from minimum rates.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (Appendix D to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective April 23, 1977, Sixty-sixth Revised Page 14 and Fourth Revised Page 14-A, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 2. Minimum Rate Tariff 1-B (Appendix B of Decision No-65834, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective April 23, 1977, Eighteenth Revised Page 14, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 3. Minimum Rate Tariff 9-B (Appendix A of Decision No. 67766, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective April 23, 1977, Eighteenth Revised Page 17, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 4. Minimum Rate Tariff 19 (Appendix A of Decision No. 41363, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective April 23, 1977, Seventeenth Revised Page 15-A, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 5. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities
 Act, to the extent that they are subject also to Decisions Nos.
 31606, 41363, 65834 and 67766, as amended, are hereby directed to
 establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with
 the further adjustments ordered herein.
- 6. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be made effective April 23, 1977, on not less than one day's notice to the Commission

and to the public and tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than April 23, 1977, and may be made effective on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than June 23, 1977.

- 7. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the amendments authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 461.5 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the amendments published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.
- 8. In all other respects Decisions Nos. 31606, 41363, 65834 and 67766, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
- 9. A consolidated hearing in these proceedings to consider whether the transportation of flattened automobile bodies and empty sea vans should be exempted from the minimum rates shall be heard before such Commissioner or Examiner and at such time and place as may hereafter be designated.
- 10. The consolidated hearing ordered herein shall be assigned numbers OSH SS in Case No. 5432, OSH 11 in Case No. 5439 and OSH SS in Case No. 5441.

The Executive Director is directed to cause appropriate notice of the hearing to be mailed at least ten (10) days before such hearing.
