<u>OPINION</u>

The complaint alleges an excess of sand, rust, and calcium in the drinking water provided by defendant's water system and a lack of water pressure at certain lots. It is suggested that a sand filter be installed and that the water be tested by chemical analysis.

Defendant's witness advised that the water has been certified as safe for human consumption although calcium is present in all water obtained from its source of supply. Defendant agreed to flush out its mains and to uncover portions of its system and to locate and replace worn or deteriorated mains.

Pursuant to Rule 13.2 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, complainants and defendant consented to the Expedited Complaint Procedure and waived the presence of a court reporter and a record of the hearing and findings of fact and conclusions of law. This matter was heard on April 14, 1977 by Examiner Fraser.

<u>ORDER</u>

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Within thirty days of the effective date of this order, Honor Oak Water Company shall flush the mains and extensions serving the fourteen homes on the lower portion of its system and will open mains and connections where necessary to remove accumulated sand or rust.
- 2. Defendant will uncover its mains and extensions in the area noted to the extent necessary to determine the age and condition of the pipes which will be replaced where needed with plastic or copper inserts.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
