ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Ordering Paragraph 2.C of Decision No. 86487 dated October 13, 1976 in Applications Nos. 55436 and 55437 provided, among other things, for the suspension of Class A Charter-party of Passengers Certificate TCP-186-A of Scenic Hyway Tours, Inc., doing business as Adams Charter Coaches, to May 2, 1977, during which time, its president and owner, Richard E. Twining, shall transfer the certificate to a responsible party. By letter dated April 7, 1977, applicant's attorney requests that the certificate extension be extended for an additional 6 months. The letter states that applicant has a buyer for the certificate but is having difficulty working out a payment schedule with him; that if this problem cannot be resolved, it will be necessary to obtain a new buyer; and that for this reason, the additional extension of time has been requested.

We find that the requested extension is reasonable and conclude that it should be granted. Because of the urgency of this matter, the order which follows will be made effective immediately.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The period of suspension of Class A Charter-party Carrier of Passengers Certificate TCP-186-A referred to in Ordering Paragraph 2.C of Decision No. 86487 is extended to November 10, 1977.

2. In all other respects, Decision No. 86487 shall remain in full force and effect.
