ORDER RE PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS

By stipulation between the respondents named hereinafter and the Commission staff, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Respondents Atlantic Richfield Company, Getty Oil Company, Mobil Oil Company, Standard Oil Company of California, Texaco, Inc., and Union Oil Company of California (hereinafter, "Stipulating Respondents") will produce to the staff of the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) all documents in its possession or under its control described in the appendix attached to the respective stipulations severally entered into between Stipulating Respondents and the Commission staff. The scope of production may be modified by agreement between the Commission's staff and counsel for Stipulating Respondents entered into hereinbefore and hereinafter.

2. Access to documents responsive to demands 8, 10 through 14, inclusive, and 18 through 21, inclusive (hereinafter referred to as "protected documents") produced by Stipulating Respondents shall be limited to the Commission and to the staff assigned to this matter. No member of either the Commission or the staff shall disclose any protected document or any information contained in any protected document unless and until it is necessary to make such disclosure in the course of a hearing or other proceeding in this matter.

3. Not later than thirty days prior to a hearing or other proceeding in this matter, the staff will inform Stipulating Respondents of the protected documents it intends to disclose in the course of the hearing or other proceeding to allow Stipulating Respondents an opportunity to seek a protective order from the examiner.

4. Within sixty days of the time when the decision of the Commission in this matter becomes final, all documents produced by Stipulating Respondents will be returned to them.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
